This is a summary of the annual report of the Smiths Group Services Corporation Welfare Plan, a health, life insurance, dental, vision, temporary disability, long-term disability and death benefits plan (Employer Identification Number 22-3015350, Plan Number 501), for the plan year August 1, 2023 through July 31, 2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Smiths Group Services Corporation has committed itself to pay certain vision, temporary disability, medical, prescription drugs and dental claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Prudential Insurance Company of America, Bluecross Blueshield of Illinois, Aetna Life Insurance Company, Hawaii Medical Service Association, Continental American Insurance Company and Cigna Health And Life Insurance Company to pay certain life insurance, temporary disability, long-term disability, personal accident, paid leave, health, HMO contract, dental, vision, indemnity contract, critical illness, accident claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending July 31, 2024 were \$4,033,366.
